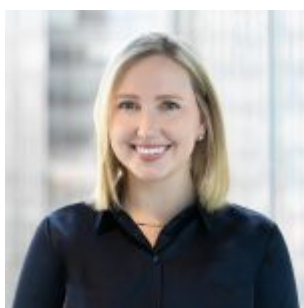
Slayton Search Partners Promotes Allison McWeeney and Bo Murray to Vice President & Principal

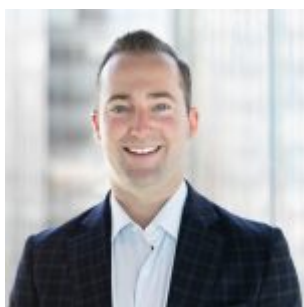
